1. On 20 June 2008, the Prosecution submitted its "Information Regarding the

Discovery and Examination of Additional Material in the Possession of the

Prosecutor" as a confidential filing.

2. The reason for the confidential classification was to ensure a harmonious

approach with an identically titled Prosecution filing submitted

contemporaneously in the case of The Prosecutor v. Germain Katanga and

Mathieu Ngudjolo Chui (hereinafter "DRC2") which, for procedural reasons

specific to that case, demanded confidential status.

3. Subsequently, and after further review, the Prosecution in DRC2 has

reclassified its filing as a public document.

4. Consequently, there no longer remains any need for the Prosecution in this

case to insist on the original confidential status.

5. The Prosecution requests, therefore, that its filing mentioned in paragraph 1

above and attached hereto as Annex I be reclassified as a public document.
