

In compliance with the orders of the Chamber contained in the Decision on the Evidence Disclosure System and Setting a Timetable for Disclosure Between the Parties,<sup>1</sup> the Office of the Prosecutor (“Prosecution”) herewith submits as Annexes A<sup>2</sup> and B<sup>3</sup> to this communication, in-depth analysis charts of truly relevant items of incriminating and potentially exonerating evidence disclosed to the Defence on 1 October 2008.

**Request for Receipt of Annex A as *Ex parte* Prosecution Only and Annex B as Confidential, Prosecution and Defence Only**

The Prosecution requests that Annex A depicting the analysis of truly relevant incriminating evidence appended to this document be received by the Chamber as “*Ex Parte* – Prosecution Only” as this annex contains identifying information of witnesses, including those for whom the Chamber has granted protection.<sup>4</sup> The Prosecution also requests that Annex B depicting analysis of truly relevant exonerating evidence appended to this document, be received by the Chamber as “Confidential – Prosecution and Defence Only” as this chart contains identifying information of witnesses who are known to the Defence, but not to the public. These requests are made to protect victims and witnesses pursuant to Article 68(1) of the Rome Statute, Rule 81(4) of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence and in compliance with the Chamber’s orders contained in the First Decision on the Prosecutor’s Request for Redactions.<sup>5</sup>
