**Trial Chamber II** of the International Criminal Court (respectively, “the Chamber” and “the Court”), acting pursuant to regulation 34 of the *Regulations of the Court*, orders the following:

1. At the status conference held on 3 February 2009, the Chamber requested the Prosecutor to file a report setting out his proposals for the protection of witnesses whom he intends to produce at trial and whose statements and interview notes he plans to disclose to the Defence.<sup>1</sup> The Prosecutor filed his report on 9 February 2009.<sup>2</sup>
2. By the present Order, the Chamber decides, pursuant to rule 34 of the *Regulations of the Court*, to reduce from 21 to 10 days the time limit for participants in the proceedings to respond to the said report.

**FOR THESE REASONS, THE CHAMBER:**

**DIRECTS** the participants to file their responses by 4.00 p.m. on 20 February 2009.
