NOTING the "Decision on the request by DRC-D01-WWWW-0019 for special protective measures relating to his asylum application " rendered by Trial Chamber I on 4 July<sup>1</sup>.

NOTING that the Registry was instructed to "*liaise with the Congolese authorities, prior to any return of defence Witness 19 to the DRC, in order to determine the extent of, and to implement, any protective measures that the Registry considers necessary.*" and that "*A report on these issues is to be filed by 29 July 2011*".<sup>2</sup>

TRANSMIT, respectfully, the following observations:

1. The Registry would like to inform the Trial Chamber that a mission is currently scheduled to embark to DRC with the planned for next week, from Tuesday 27 July until 29 July 2011 in order to consult wit the DRC authorities on the possible protective measures with regards to Witness 19.


