**NOTING** the Order of Trial Chamber III (the "Chamber") dated 29 July 2011<sup>1</sup> that the Registry file, by 28 November 2011, certain applications for participation in the present case which were referred to in the Registry's Confidential Report of 3 June 2011 ("the Registry's Report of 3 June 2011");<sup>2</sup>

**NOTING** article 68(3) of the Rome Statute, rule 89(1) of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence and regulation 86 (4), (5) and (7) of the Regulations of the Court;

**CONSIDERING** that 128 applications for participation have previously been transmitted to the Chamber, the parties and the participants but have since been supplemented with further information as explained in the Registry's Report of 3 June 2011;

**CONSIDERING** that a further 47 applications for participation have been processed and redacted in accordance with the guidelines established by the Chamber;<sup>3</sup>

**CONSIDERING** that the Registry will transmit these 175 applications in redacted form to the parties and the legal representatives of the applicants in accordance with the Chamber's instructions;<sup>4</sup>

**CONSIDERING** that the Registry has also prepared and will transmit to the Chamber an individual report for each of the applications annexed to this report in accordance with regulation 86(5) of the Regulations of the Court;


