- 1. On 26 March 2012, the Pre-trial Chamber issued an Order in relation to the reclassification of documents¹ ("Order") in which it ordered the Libyan authorities, the Registrar, the Prosecutor, and the OPCD, to (i) identify which, if any, of their respective filings as set out in the annexes should retain redactions or a confidential or confidential *ex parte* classification, providing reasons as to the necessity of maintaining the relevant redactions or classification; and (ii) in relation to those filings which cannot be reclassified as public, to file proposals for redactions, providing reasons as to the necessity of the proposed redactions.
- 2. The Prosecution herewith complies with this Order and provides the required explanations for the three documents identified by the Chamber in the Confidential *ex parte* Annex 1. Given that the Chamber's Order refers to the relevant Prosecution filings in an *ex parte* Annex, the Prosecution has provided its explanations concerning the reclassification of each of the filings in *ex parte* Annex A. The proposed publicly redacted filing is filed as Confidential and *ex parte* Annex B.
