- 1. On 27 December 2012, the Prosecution filed its "Third application for delayed disclosure of witness identities", with confidential ex parte Prosecution and Victims and Witnesses Unit Only Annexes 1-5 ("Third Delayed Disclosure Application"), requesting delayed disclosure of, inter alia, P-0534.1
- 2. The Prosecution hereby submits confidential ex parte Prosecution and VWU only Annex A, which includes the draft transcripts of the interview of P-0534 with the proposed redactions thereto, and an explanatory chart. The interview of P-0534 took place [REDACTED].<sup>2</sup> The transcripts were not available on 27 December when the Third Delayed Disclosure Application was filed.<sup>3</sup> Annex A also includes material related to P-0534's re-interview - 1 sketch - which was drawn by the witness during the interview.
- 3. Annex A is designated confidential ex parte because it contains "see through" redactions to assist the Chamber. The Prosecution respectfully requests the Chamber to consider this material when ruling upon the Third Delayed Disclosure Application.
