Section

I. Introduction

1. The Office of the Prosecutor ("Prosecution") herewith submits this Communication Report¹ regarding Incriminating and Rule 77 evidence disclosed to the Defence teams of Jean-Pierre Bemba Gombo, Aimé Kilolo Musamba, Jean-Jacques Mangenda Kabongo and Fidèle Babala Wandu on 10 March 2014.²

2. The disclosure was made pursuant to, and in accordance with, the Chamber's 4 December Order,³ 28 January Decision,⁴ and 31 January Decision.⁵ Additionally, the Prosecution disclosed Rule 77 materials to the Defence teams, in accordance with its on-going obligations.

II. Request for Confidentiality

3. The Prosecution requests that Annexes A and B, appended to this Report, be received as "Confidential" as they relate to evidence disclosed *inter partes* that should not be released to the public.
