#### I. Introduction

1. The Office of the Prosecutor ("Prosecution") hereby responds to the Babala Defence's request for access to records submitted by the Dutch authorities to the Independent Counsel pertaining to recorded telephone communications which the Single Judge assigned Independent Counsel to review for relevance to the case and to exclude privileged material ("Request").¹ The Request should be dismissed as moot.

#### III. Submissions
