In keeping with prior practice to keep the Trial Chamber (“Chamber”) informed of the execution of its disclosure obligations, and in accordance with the Chamber’s “Order regarding redactions”,¹ the Office of the Prosecutor (“Prosecution”) herewith submits its communication to the Defence of incriminatory evidence, materials disclosed pursuant to Article 67(2) of the Rome Statute as well as materials pursuant to Rule 77 of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence.
2. On 12 September 2014, the Prosecution disclosed 72 items, as listed in Confidential Annex A; on 15 September, it disclosed nine items as listed in Confidential Annex B and on 18 September, it disclosed 13 items as listed in Confidential Annex C.²
