- 1. P-0800 commenced his testimony on 17 November 2014.¹ At the conclusion of his examination in chief by the Office of the Prosecutor ("Prosecution") on 20 November 2014, Trial Chamber V(A) directed the Prosecution to submit a filing in respect of the 10 items that the Prosecution used during its questioning of the witness that it wished to tender into evidence.²
