PRE-TRIAL CHAMBER II (the "Chamber") of the International Criminal Court (the "Court");

NOTING the Prosecution's "Urgent Application for Authorization to Disclose Information Relating to the Warrants of Arrest and Requests for Arrest and Surrender Transmitted to the Central African Republic" ("CAR"), dated 10 March 2008 and received on 11 March 2008 (the "Prosecution's Application");¹

NOTING the Prosecution's request "that the Registry and/or the Prosecution be granted authorization to inform representatives of States and international bodies of the transmission to the CAR of the Warrants of Arrest and Requests for Arrest and Surrender at the earliest possible opportunity";

NOTING the warrant of arrest for JOSEPH KONY, issued by the Chamber on 8 July 2005, as amended on 27 September 2005,² and the warrants of arrest issued for VINCENT OTTI,³ OKOT ODHIAMBO⁴ and DOMINIC ONGWEN⁵ on 8 July 2005 (the "Warrants");

NOTING the "Decision to Issue Requests for Arrest and Surrender to the Central African Republic", dated 21 March 2007, in which the Chamber issued requests for arrest and surrender of JOSEPH KONY,6 VINCENT OTTI,7 OKOT ODHIAMBO8 and DOMINIC ONGWEN;9

NOTING the requests to the CAR for arrest and surrender of JOSEPH KONY,¹⁰ VINCENT OTTI,¹¹ OKOT ODHIAMBO¹² and DOMINIC ONGWEN¹³, dated 21 March 2007 (the "Requests"), in which the Chamber, *inter alia*, ordered the Registrar to transmit to the CAR the Requests and the enclosed documentation, including copies of the Warrants and the Annexes thereto, with a view to their execution;

NOTING the reasons submitted in support of the Prosecution's Application, in particular those relating to the need to "best preserve the opportunity to arrest the individuals sought";

CONSIDERING the Chamber's inherent power to take appropriate measures to ensure the effectiveness of the proceedings;

NOTING regulation 46 (2) of the Regulations of the Court, according to which the Chamber is "responsible for any matter, request or information arising out of the situation assigned to it";

CONSIDERING that, for the purpose of disclosing information relating to the transmission of the Warrants and the Requests to the CAR, it is important that the Prosecutor and the Registrar act in fullest and closest consultation and cooperation;

HAVING REGARD THERETO AND FOR THESE REASONS;

ORDERS that the Prosecution's Application and this Decision be kept under seal until further order by the Chamber.
