Introduction

1. The Office of the Prosecutor (“Prosecution”) provides notice of the disclosure of incriminatory evidence pursuant to articles 64(3)(c) and 67(1)(a) and (b) of the Rome Statute.

Disclosure of evidence

2. On 20 March 2015, the Prosecution provided the Defence with advance copies of the interview transcripts and other materials related to Witness P-0901, as announced in the “Prosecution withdrawal of its application for delayed disclosure for P-0901”.¹ The Prosecution formally disclosed the same materials, as well as the audio recordings of the interview, on 26 March 2015.
3. The Prosecution appends the list of the evidence disclosed in Confidential Annex A.
