Introduction

1. The Office of the Prosecutor (“Prosecution”) provides notice of the disclosure of material falling within rule 77 of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence (“the Rules”).

Disclosure of evidence

2. On 2 June 2015, the Prosecution disclosed a total of 51 items under rule 77 of the Rules.
3. The Prosecution disclosed, under rule 77, the audio-recordings of a recent re-interview of a Prosecution witness. The Prosecution has filed a request pursuant to regulation 35 to vary the time limit for the disclosure of these items as incriminating evidence.¹ It will re-disclose them under that classification should the Trial Chamber grant its request and thereafter add them to its List of Evidence.
4. The Prosecution also provided the Defence with 47 advance copies of the draft Kinyarwanda translations of two interviews of two Prosecution witnesses. Each interview is comprised of several transcripts that are individually translated.
5. The Prosecution appends the list of the evidence disclosed in Confidential Annex A.
