1. On 21 October 2011, Trial Chamber III (“Chamber”) issued its “Decision on the ‘Defence request for modification of redactions’”.¹ In this decision, the Chamber ordered the Office of the Prosecutor (“Prosecution”) to lift redactions in the statement of Witness CAR-OTP-PPPP-0213 (“Witness 213”) pertaining to [REDACTED].²

2. On 25 October 2011, the Prosecution sought the Chamber's guidance and suggested to amend its list of evidence by replacing the older version of Witness 213’s statement with the newer, less redacted version.³ The Chamber approved the Prosecution’s proposal to amend the list of evidence accordingly.⁴ Pursuant to the approval, the Prosecution hereby submits the English and French versions of the amended list of evidence in Annexes A and B.

3. The Prosecution requests that this submission and its accompanying Annexes A and B be received by the Chamber as “Confidential” as they relate to confidential information that is not known to the public.
