I. Introduction

1. Pursuant to paragraph 17 of Trial Chamber I's "Decision on the resumption of action applications" ("Decision") issued on 11 October 2017, 1 the Registry hereby transmits the third updated consolidated list ("List") of victims participating in the case of The Prosecutor v. Laurent Gbagbo and Charles Blé Goudé ("Case").

II. **Procedural history**

- 2. On 11 October 2017, Trial Chamber I ("Chamber") adopted the following procedure for the submission of applications for resumption of action: 1) when a participating victim dies, the legal representative of the victims ("LRV") informs the Victims Participation and Reparations Section ("VPRS"); 2) VPRS has then to amend the consolidated list of participating victims ("List") accordingly, and to file an updated List in which any granted resumption of action must be reflected at least twice per calendar year until the conclusion of the proceedings before the Chamber;² 3) VPRS should also transmit these applications for resumption of action, including the necessary supporting materials, to the Chamber and, at the same time, to the parties in a redacted version as necessary.3
- 3. So far, the Registry transmitted two updated consolidated list of participating victims in the record of the Case.4
- 4. On 9 November 2018, the LRV informed the VPRS of the death of 10 participating victims in the Case,⁵ and transmitted to the VPRS documents

concerning the resumption of action on behalf of the deceased participating victims in their original version and provided to the VPRS the proposed redacted version of the documents. ⁶

III. Submissions

- 5. The Registry has amended the List in light of the information received from the LRV on 9 November 2018, and transmits it in the record of the Case.
- 6. Therefore, the information presented in the List reflects the current total number of 716 participating victims.⁷
