I. INTRODUCTION

1. The Prosecution hereby notifies Trial Chamber I (“Chamber”) of the disclosure of evidence pursuant to articles 64(3)(c) and 67(1)(a) and (b) of the Rome Statute, and rules 76(3) and 77 of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence.

II. CLASSIFICATION

2. This filing is classified as public with one confidential annex, comprising the list of evidence disclosed to the Defence. This annex is classified as confidential since it contains confidential information.

III. SUBMISSIONS

3. On 18 March 2022, the Prosecution disclosed to the Defence three packages of evidence consisting of 56 items (628 pages):
 - Pre-Trial INCRIM package 107, containing 27 items (72 pages), including material related to three witnesses;¹
 - Pre-Trial INCRIM package 108, consisting of 12 items (213 pages), including material related to nine witnesses;²
 - Pre-Trial Rule 77 package 68, containing 17 items (343 pages), including material related to two witnesses.³

4. With respect to redactions, the Prosecution applied “standard” redactions to new items pursuant to the procedure for exceptions to disclosure adopted by the Single Judge of Pre-Trial Chamber II on 17 August 2020.⁴
