CMS is presently addressing the backlog of email decisions reports in accordance with the Directions on the Conduct of Proceedings, ICC-01/14-01/21-251 dated 09 March 2022.

Pursuant to paragraph 64 of the Directions, which instructs the Registry to "simultaneously file public and confidential versions of these reports" and mindful of the current delay, CMS seeks the Chamber's authorization to initially file the 2023 Reports (January-March, April-June, July-September and October-December 2023) in their confidential version first.
