Noting that Mr Ngaïssona's current restrictions allow for visits (see ICC-01/14-01/18-2177-Conf, para. 31), the Single Judge sees no reason to prohibit [REDACTED] visiting Mr Ngaïssona, as long as this visit takes place *after* [REDACTED] is completed and complies with the procedures in place at the detention centre, in particular regarding the security vetting of visitors. The Single Judge further instructs the [REDACTED] to inform [REDACTED] that discussions related to the present case, as well as the use of obscure or coded language, is prohibited.
