Dear colleagues of Trial Chamber V,

On behalf of the Registry I bring your kind attention to the message below and would be very grateful if you could kindly convey it to the Chamber:

With reference to the 'Order Requesting Observations from relevant States on Interim Release' dated 20 March 2020 (ICC-01/14-01/18-461) the CAR authorities have contacted the Registry asking whether the Chamber could kindly grant them an extension of time to submit their observations on the request for interim release of Mr. Yekatom.

The authorities are asking until 14 April 2020 to submit their observations instead of the initial deadline of 9 April 2020.

In this regard the Registry notes that it took time for the Registry to translate the Order of the Chamber into French and to notify the request to the authorities. In addition, the CAR authorities made reference to logistical problems to compile their observations and transmit their observations to the Court.

Should the Chamber grant the request, the Registry respectfully proposes to file only one report on 14 April 2020 explaining why CAR is filing late and transmitting both their observations and those of the Host State, if this would be acceptable to the Chamber.

The Registry remains at the Chamber's disposal for any additional information in relation to this request.
